Duration	The project will have a seven-year implementation period, including
	installation and support periods for operators
Location	Nkouo, Odziba, Imvouba, Hinda.

	Congo has (i) a diversity of agro-ecological areas conducive to agropastoral and fisheries activities, (ii) a relatively young population, and (iii) sufficient land resources with an ecology that lends itself to the development of several varieties of livestock.
Context	Despite these advantages, the level of agropastoral and fisheries production remains low and the country is forced to resort to imports of expensive plant and especially meat products.
	Faced with the constraints and challenges of the agriculture, livestock and fishing sectors, as well as those related to youth employment, the Government of Congo has initiated in its National Development Programme various agricultural development activities such as the creation of the two new farming villages that have been established and which produce table eggs, broilers and vegetables.
	This experience deserves to be reproduced elsewhere in the country in order to solve the problem of rural youth employment and the lack of fresh animal and plant products.
Justification Project	Through this project, Congo will initiate Agropoles that consist of (i) experimenting with the grouping of populations in the same locality; (ii) promote land use planning; (iii) ensuring land security; (iv) promoting the stabilization of young agricultural actors; (v) reducing rural exodus; and (vi) promote the development of various pastoral agribusiness activities.

	The New Agricultural Village is defined as a geographic area with decent
	habitats and hydro-agricultural developments where economic



	development activities in the agricultural, agricultural, livestock, and
	fishing industry occurs in a holistic fashion.
Development	In this developed area, moderate-cost housing is created that serves as
strategy	residences for new residents, primarily female and male operators.
	To stimulate, support and accelerate socio-economic development in settlement areas, the New Agricultural Villages are equipped with all the amenities related to the living environment of the population (electricity, drinking water points, equipment health, education, market, and agricultural processing industry unit, etc.).
	There will be a pre-selection phase based on the files and a final selection of operators after an interview with the selection committee.
	Priority will be given to rural farmers as well as professional farmers
	leaving agricultural training institutes or centres.
	The gender aspect will be taken into account and in this case, women will represent at least 30% of the successful candidates.
